Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.99 million eggs in incubators during the week ending November 25, down 6 percent from the week prior and down 4 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of November 25, was 3.69 million, up 10 percent from the previous week but down 35 percent from the previous year. **Texas** hatcheries set 18.5 million eggs in incubators during the week ending November 25, down 1 percent from the week prior but up 3 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of November 25, was 13.5 million, down 8 percent from the previous week and down slightly from the previous year.
