Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.04 million eggs in incubators during the week ending April 6, down 4 percent from the week prior and down 20 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of April 6, was 3.62 million, down 9 percent from the previous week and down 26 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 19.3 million eggs in incubators during the week ending April 6, up slightly from the week prior and up 4 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of April 6, was 14.8 million, up 2 percent from the previous week but down 1 percent from the previous year.
