CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION WEEK ENDING SEPTEMBER 6, 2015

AGRICULTURAL SUMMARY: Farmers have started planting winter wheat along with harvesting safflower. Onions are being lifted in preparation for harvest. Corn silage harvest will begin within the upcoming weeks throughout the state. Stock water supplies were rated 15 percent very short, 31 percent short, and 54 percent adequate.
