## CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION WEEK ENDING OCTOBER 4, 2015

**AGRICULTURAL SUMMARY:** Producers are almost half-way through moving cattle and sheep from summer range. Farmers continue harvesting corn for silage and onions throughout the state, with progress for both ahead of the 5-year average. Stock water supplies were rated 16 percent very short, 31 percent short, and 53 percent adequate.
