## CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION WEEK ENDING NOVEMBER 29, 2015

**AGRICULTURAL SUMMARY:** Corn harvested for grain continued with 85 percent, which is behind last year's 88 percent as well as behind the 5-year average of 86 percent. Producers continue moving cattle from summer range slightly behind previous year with 95 percent of cattle moved compared with a 5-year average of 99 percent. Livestock are receiving supplemental feed with 25 percent of cattle and 38 percent of sheep being fed. Hay and roughage supplies were rated 54 percent adequate and 46 percent surplus. Stock water supplies were rated 12 percent very short, 25 percent short, and 63 percent adequate.

**Note:** This report concludes the weekly crop progress report for 2015. Next year's Utah weekly report will begin in April 2016.

Monthly reports will be released for December on Monday, January 4, 2016; for January on Monday, February 1, 2016; for February on Monday, February 29, 2016; and for March on Monday, March 28, 2016.
