CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION WEEK ENDING NOVEMBER 8, 2020

AGRICULTURAL SUMMARY: Warm weather with weekend precipitation occurred throughout the state last week, according to the Mountain Regional Field Office of the National Agricultural Statistics Service. Topsoil moisture level conditions rated adequate to surplus increased from 17 percent last week to 23 percent. Corn mature and corn harvested for grain are at 95 percent complete and 78 percent complete, respectively. Statewide, winter wheat planted and winter wheat emergence are at 88 percent complete and 68 percent complete, respectively. With continued dry conditions, cattle and sheep being moved from pasture were both 89 percent moved, and cattle and sheep receiving supplemental feed were at 56 percent and 36 percent, respectively. Beaver County reports livestock producers were feeding hay due to the drought. Hay and roughage supplies were rated 13 percent short, 77 percent adequate, and 10 percent surplus. Stock water supplies were rated 27 percent very short, 45 percent short, and 28 percent adequate.
