CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION MONTH OF JANUARY 2022

AGRICULTURAL SUMMARY: Mild temperatures along with isolated snowstorms occurred throughout the state for the month of January, according to the Mountain Regional Field Office of the National Agricultural Statistics Service, USDA. Topsoil moisture level conditions rated adequate to surplus increased from 89 percent last month to 90 percent. Box Elder county reports livestock producers were feeding cattle and treating cattle for parasites. Cattle and calves and sheep and lambs receiving supplemental feed are at 72 percent and 57 percent, respectively. Beaver county reports livestock are doing well, since it has been a mild January. As of January 24, 2022, snowpack in Utah was 112 percent measured as percent of median snowfall. Hay and roughage supplies were rated 55 percent very short, 30 percent short, and 15 percent adequate. Stock water supplies were rated 1 percent very short, 19 percent short, 79 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus.
