## CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION WEEK ENDING FEBRUARY 2022

**AGRICULTURAL SUMMARY:** Mild winter temperatures along with isolated snowstorms occurred throughout the state for the month of February, according to the Mountain Regional Field Office of the National Agricultural Statistics Service, USDA. Topsoil moisture level conditions rated adequate to surplus decreased from 90 percent last month to 63 percent. Box Elder county reports livestock producers were busy tending to calving cows with no issues reported due to the mild winter. Cattle and calves and sheep and lambs receiving supplemental feed were at 85 percent and 60 percent, respectively. Calving and lambing were 6 percent and 10 percent, respectively. As of February 18, 2022, snowpack in Utah was 83 percent measured as percent of median snowfall. Hay and roughage supplies were rated 19 percent very short, 37 percent short, and 44 percent adequate. Stock water supplies were rated 3 percent very short, 49 percent short, and 48 percent adequate.

**Note:** A monthly report will be released for March on Monday, March 28, 2022. The first weekly report will be released on Monday, April 4, 2022.
