<u>Agricultural News:</u> Days suitable for fieldwork were 4.9. Weather conditions were mostly cool and rain was spotty. Many fields were wet from the previous precipitation from Hurricane Delta, delaying some harvesting. Average high temperatures were in the 60s to 70s. Farming activities for the week included making hay, harvesting soybeans, and assisting with fall calving.




