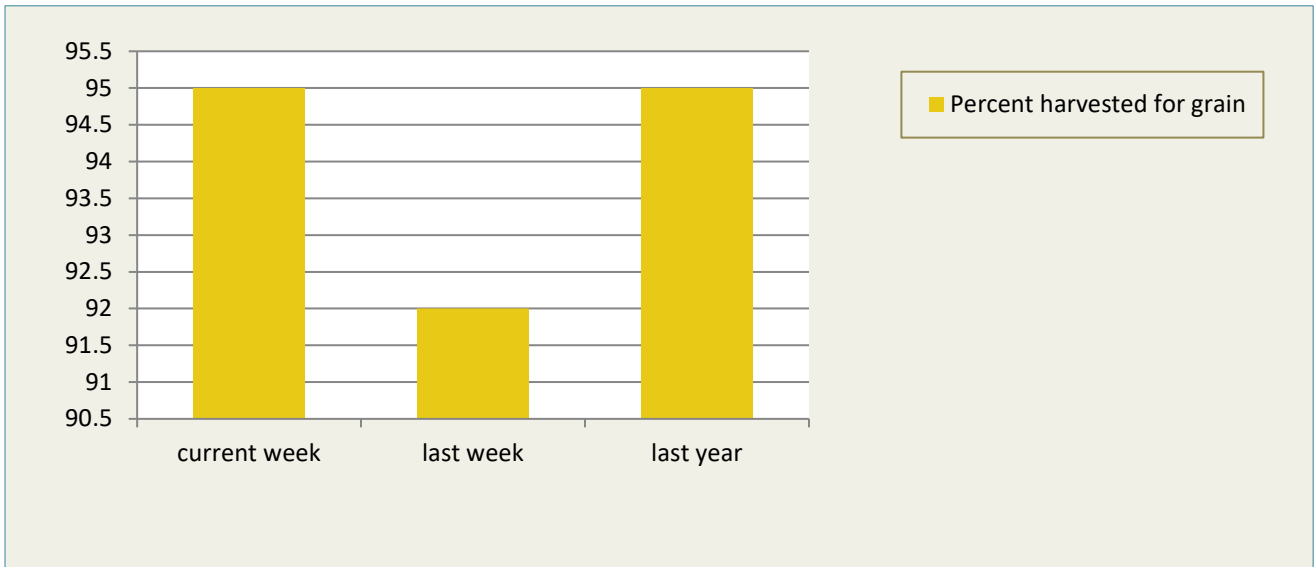

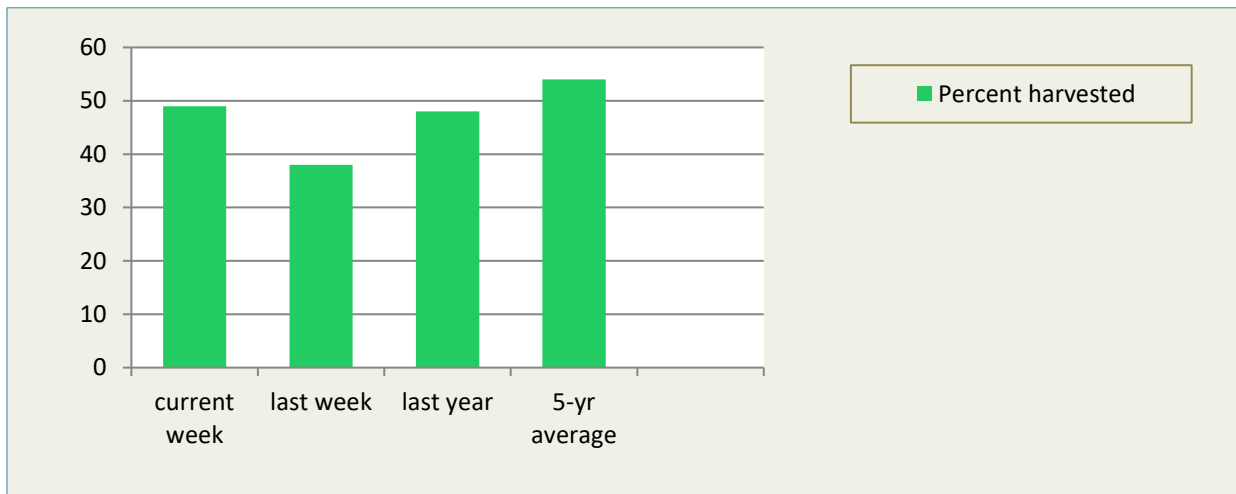

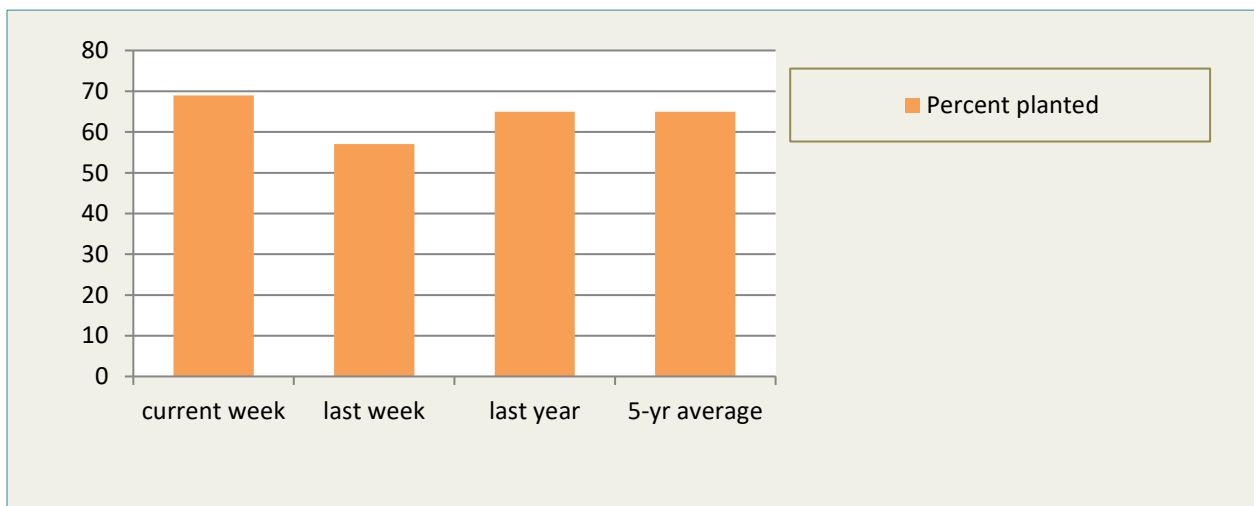
CORN HARVESTED FOR GRAIN for week ending 11/07/21
