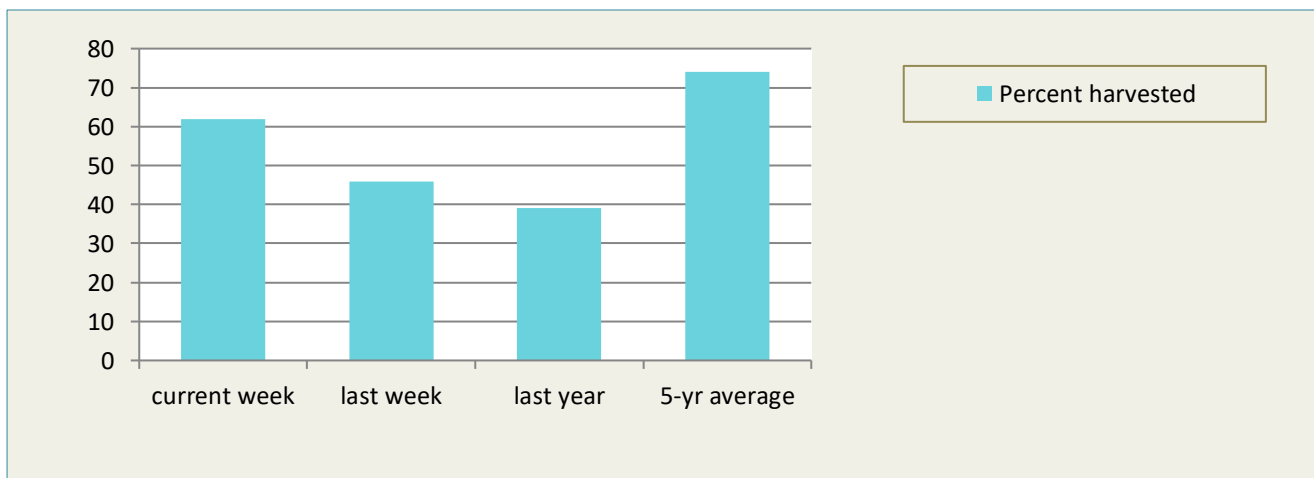

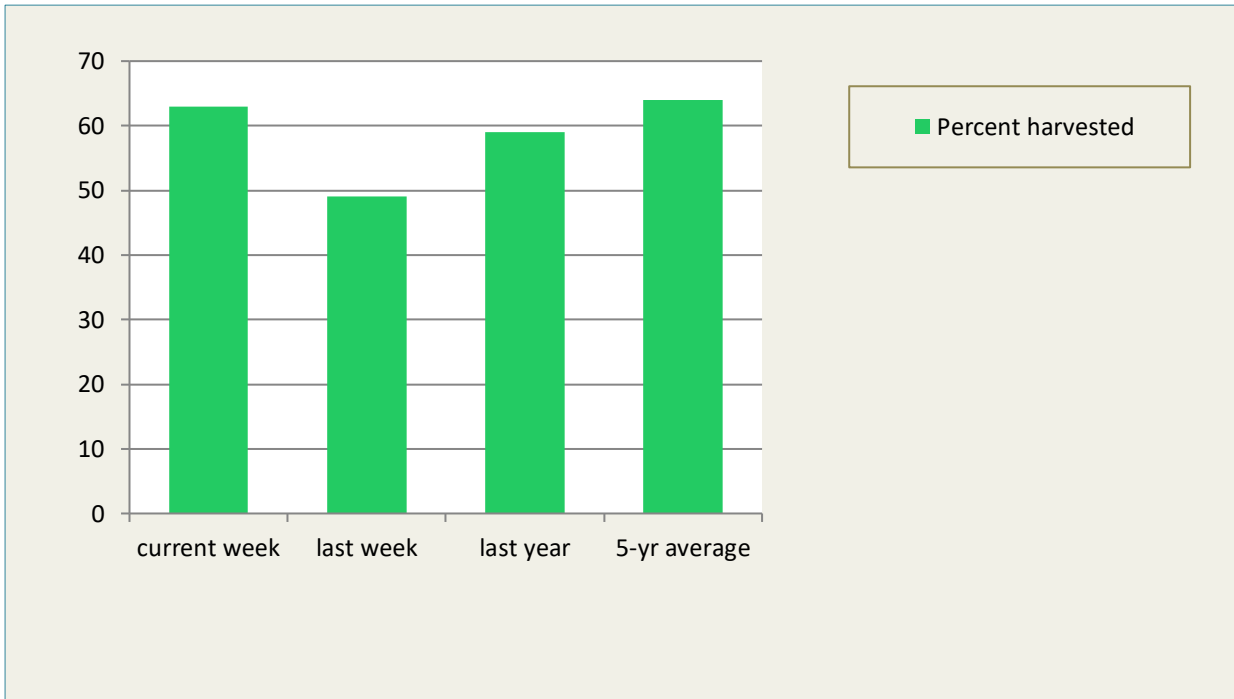

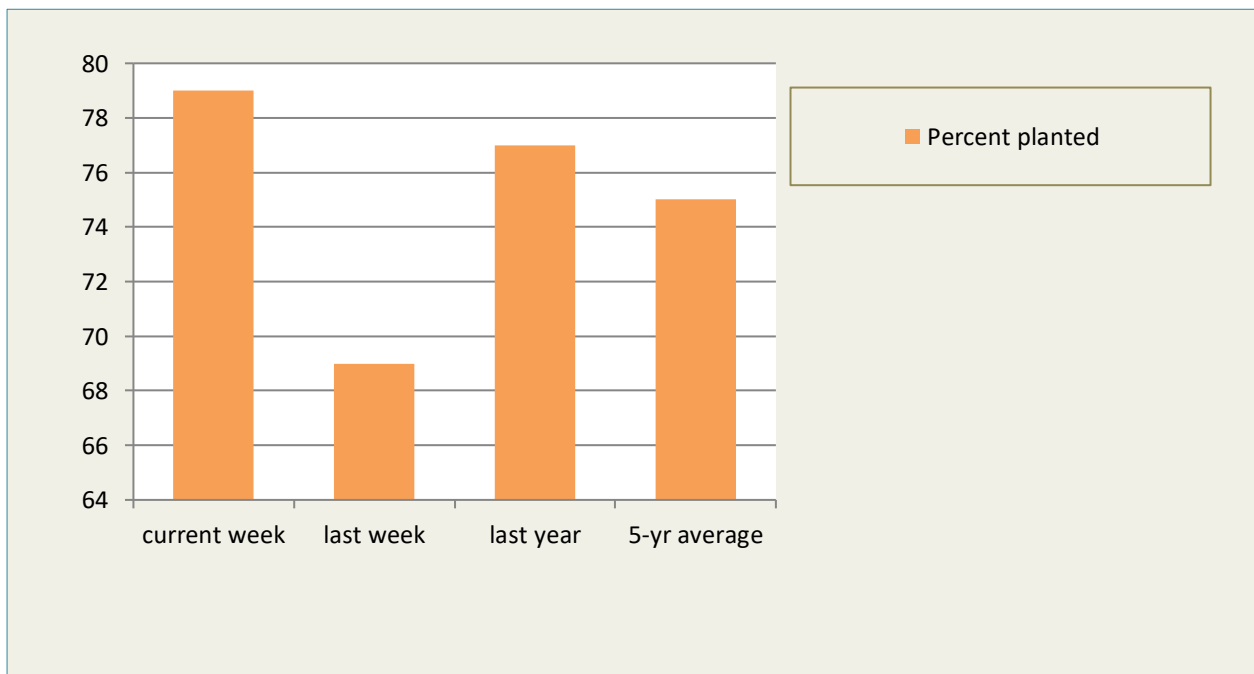
## COTTON for week ending 11/14/21
