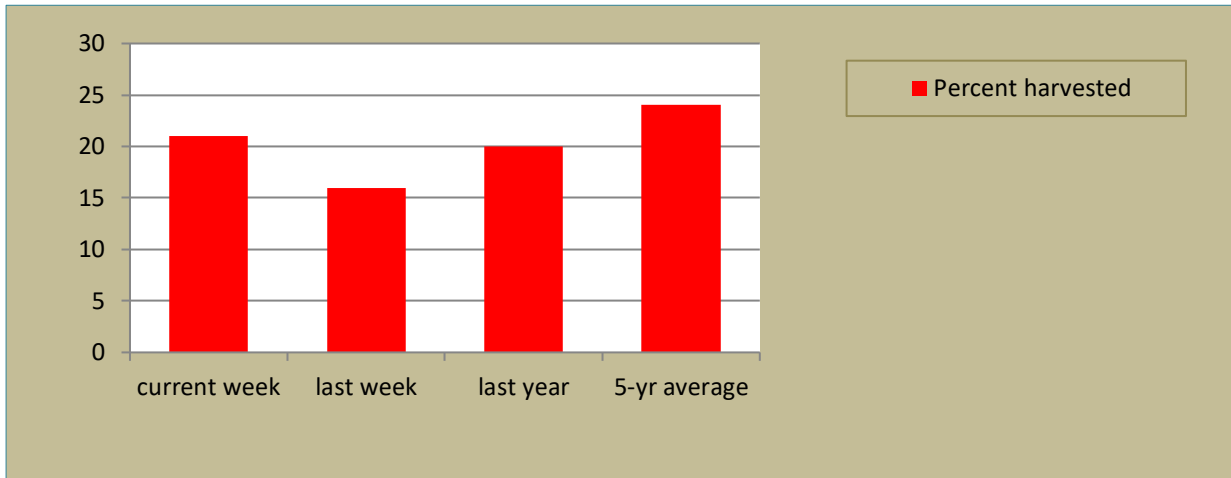

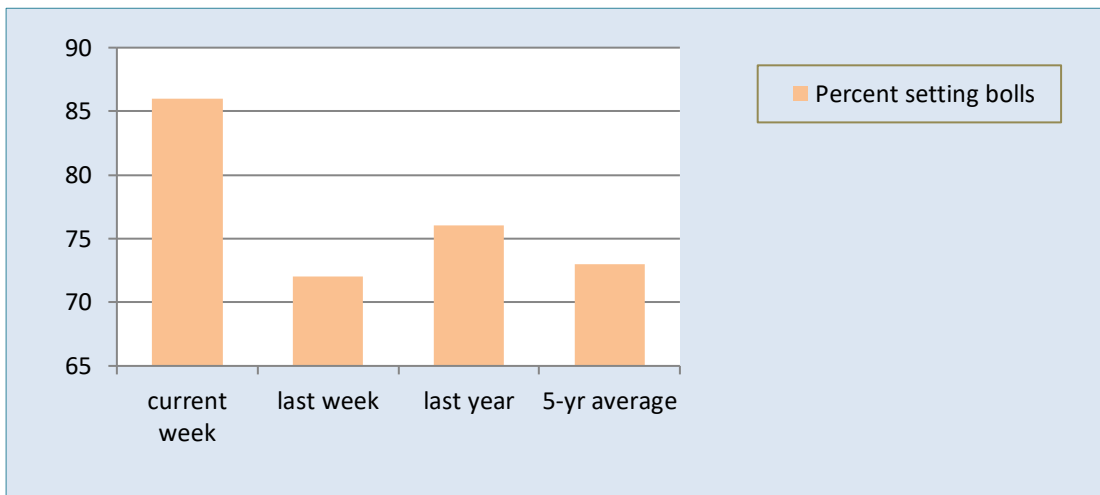

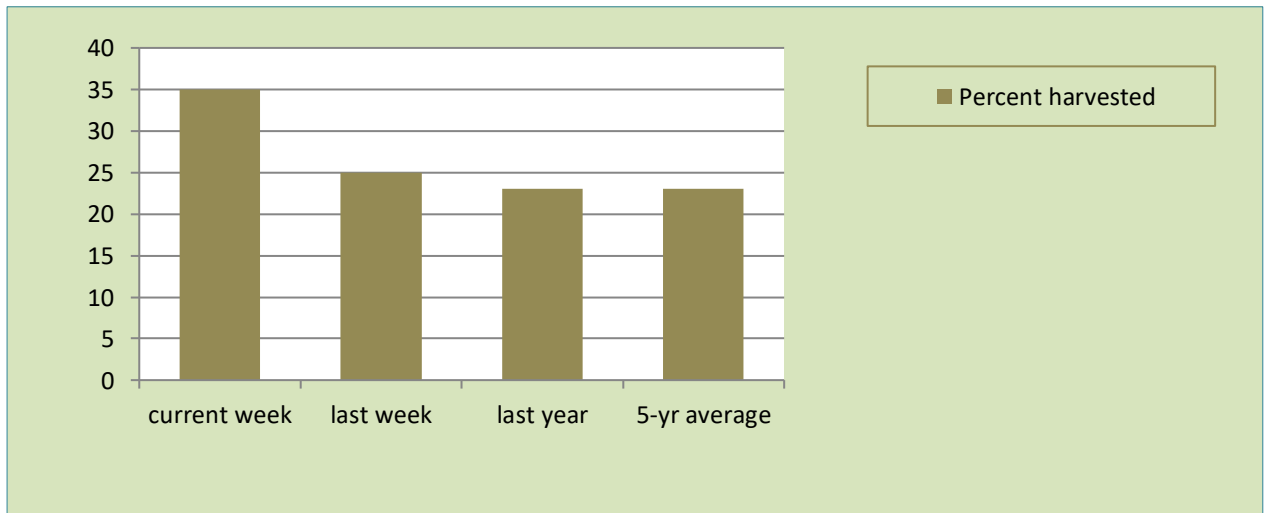
APPLES HARVESTED for week ending 8/07/22
