Farming activities for the week included planting double crop soybeans, harvesting wheat, and making hay.

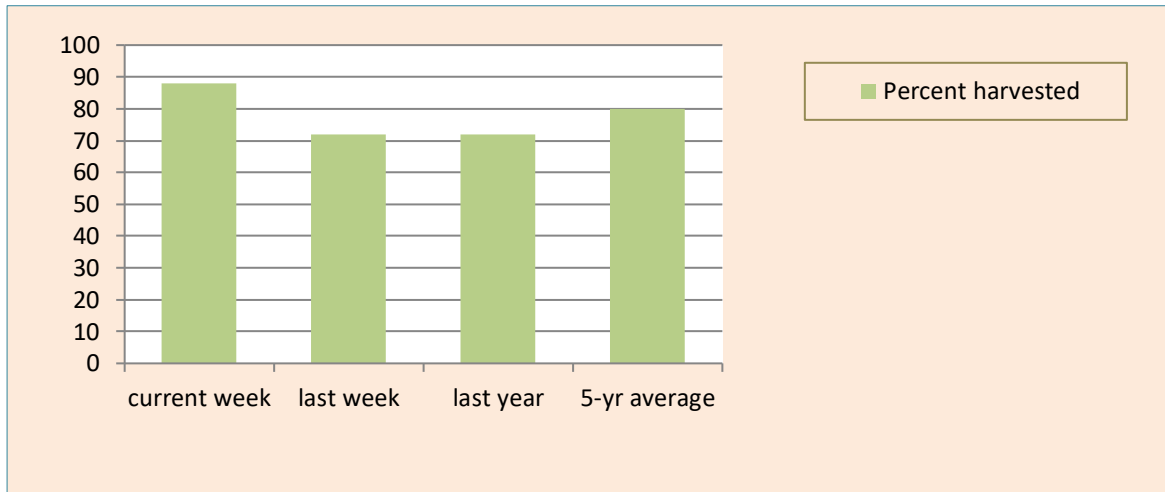

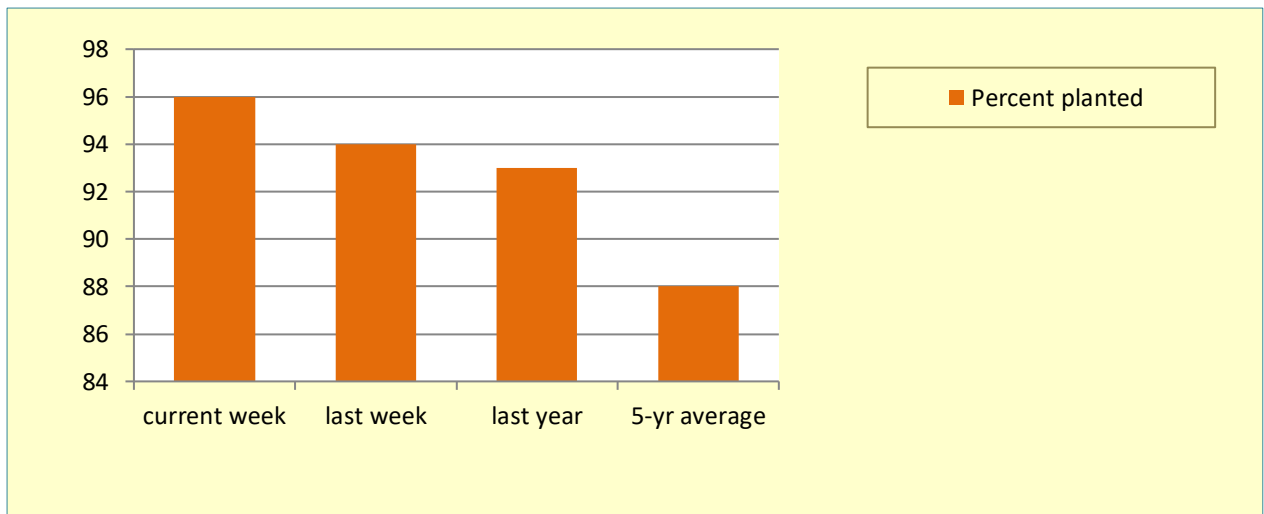

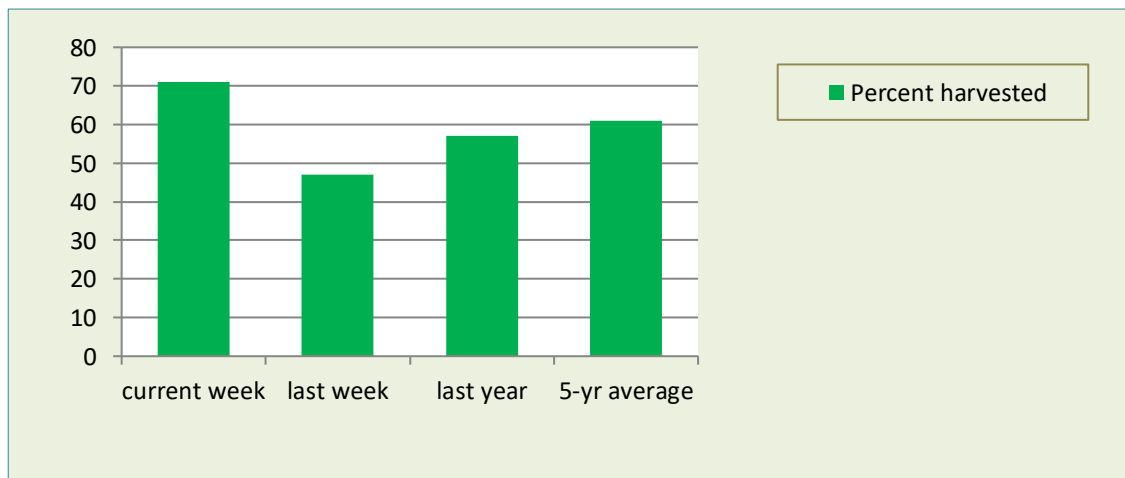
BARLEY HARVESTED FOR GRAIN for week ending 6/26/22
