### **Alaska**

The total crop value at wholesale for all growers with \$10,000 or more in sales is estimated at \$7.25 million for 2019, up from \$7.02 million in 2018. The number of producers for 2019 was 50 producers, down 1. Total covered area used for floriculture crop production in 2019 was 863 thousand square feet, down 19 percent from 2018. Greenhouse space for 2019, at 866 thousand square feet, was down 19 percent from 2018. Open ground totaled 140 acres in 2019, up 159 percent from 2018.

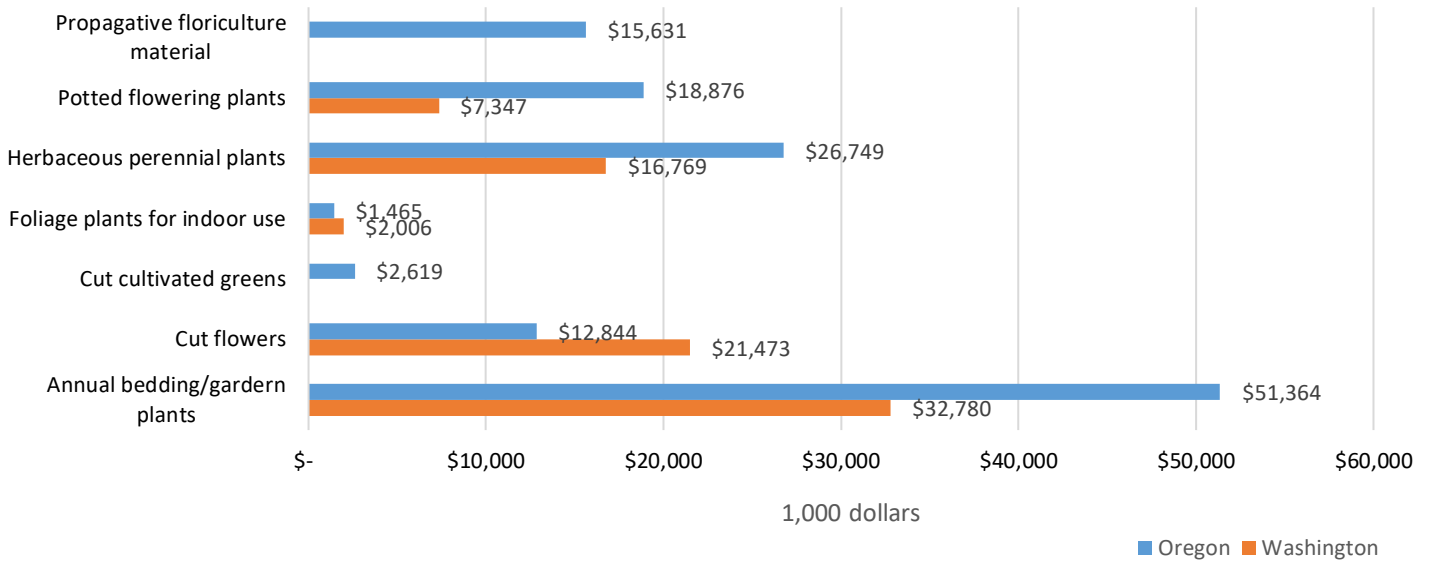
### **Oregon**

The total crop value at wholesale for all growers with \$10,000 or more in sales is estimated at \$134 million for 2019, compared with \$166 million for 2018. The number of producers for 2019, at 216, is down from the 2018 count of 259. Total covered area for floriculture crop production was 28.5 million square feet, up 47 percent from 2018. Greenhouse space for 2019, at 24.0 million square feet, was up 42 percent from 2018. Open ground totaled 10,822 acres, up 255 percent from the 2018 total.

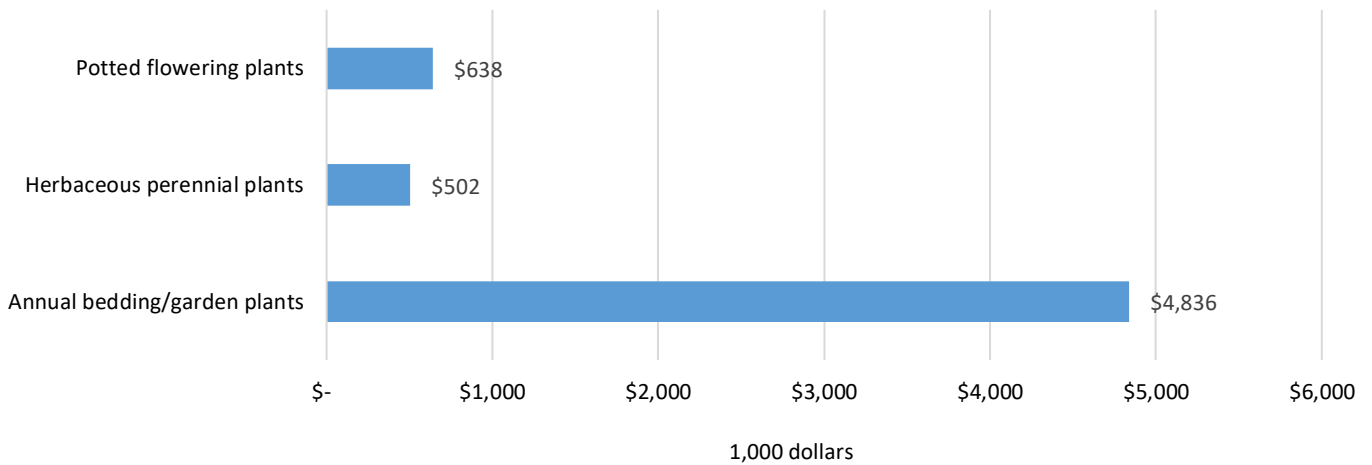
### **Washington**

The total crop value at wholesale for all growers with \$10,000 or more in sales is estimated at \$94.4 million for 2019, compared with \$135 million for 2018. The number of producers for 2019, at 197, is down from the 2018 count of 277. Total covered area for floriculture crop production was 13.2 million square feet, up 49 percent from 2018. Greenhouse space for 2019, at 13.0 million square feet, was up 53 percent from 2018. Open ground totaled 4,524 acres, up 112 percent from the 2018 total.
