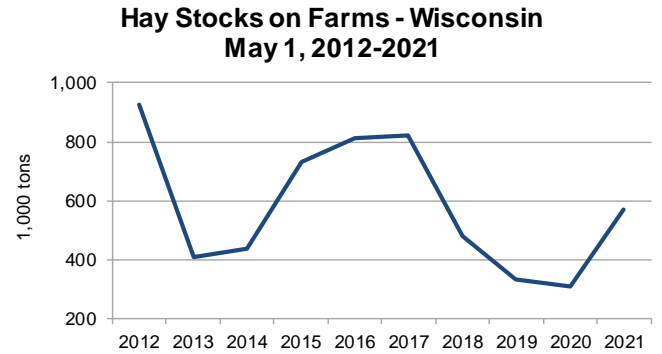

All hay stored on Wisconsin farms as of May 1, 2021, is estimated at 570,000 tons, an increase of 84% from May 1, 2020, according to the latest USDA, National Agricultural Statistics Service – *Crop Production* report. Disappearance from December 1, 2020, through May 1, 2021, totaled 1.22 million tons, compared with 1.46 million tons for the same period a year earlier.

UNITED STATES HIGHLIGHTS

All hay stored on United States farms as of May 1, 2021 totaled 18.0 million tons, down 12% from May 1, 2020. Disappearance from December 1, 2020 - May 1, 2021 totaled 66.0 million tons, up 3% from the same period a year earlier.
