The January 2021 average price received by farmers for **corn** in Wisconsin was \$4.12 per bushel according to the latest USDA, National Agricultural Statistics Service – *Agricultural Prices* report. This was up 32 cents from December and 46 cents above the previous January.

The January **soybean** price, at \$10.60 per bushel, was down 50 cents from December, but \$1.97 above the previous January.

The January **oat** price was \$4.07 per bushel, \$1.29 cents above the December price and \$1.10 above January 2020.

All hay prices in Wisconsin averaged \$153.00 per ton in January, down \$14.00 from December and \$33.00 below January 2020. The **alfalfa hay** price averaged \$161.00 per ton in January, down \$17.00 from December and \$30.00 below the previous January. The **other hay** price averaged \$115.00, down \$9.00 from December and down \$48.00 from the January 2020 price.

The January average price for **milk** was \$17.50 per cwt, down \$.60 from December and \$1.90 below January a year ago.


