



Wyoming Crop Weather



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Released: Tuesday, November 13, 2007

Week of November 5 – November 11, 2007

AGRICULTURAL SUMMARY: Unseasonably warm days persist.

Topsoil moisture declines.

Crop harvests nearing completion.

Temperatures continue to be unseasonably warm across the State. All Stations reported averages above normal for the week. Precipitation was only reported at the Afton Station. Temperatures ranged from 6.0 degrees to 12.0 degrees above normal with highs mostly in the 60's. Lows reported were mostly in the mid-teens and low 20's. Soil moisture levels are on the decline. Topsoil moisture levels were rated at 45 percent adequate or better, down 8 points from last week, and subsoil moisture levels were rated at 24 percent adequate or better.

FIELD CROP REPORT: There were 6.9 days suitable for field work. Corn crop conditions were stable at 66 percent good or better. Corn harvested for grain was 69 percent complete, 2 points ahead of average and 2 points behind this time last year. Sugarbeet harvest was nearly complete. The 2008 winter wheat conditions fell slightly in the good category, down 1 point from last week with 93 percent reported as good or better.

LIVESTOCK, PASTURE, AND RANGE REPORT: Even with the week's lack of moisture, stockwater supplies were adequate or better in 57 percent of the state.

WEATHER SUMMARY: Afton was the only Station reporting any rainfall with 0.01 inches. Torrington had the highest temperature recorded of 73 degrees. The low temperature was reported in Big Piney at 11 degrees.


