**AGRICULTURAL SUMMARY:** Rangeland vegetation looks great. It is still green but getting dryer. Most ranchers are gathering and selling their calves. So far it has been a mild fall. Weather allowed for 6.1 days of fieldwork for the week.

**FIELD CROP REPORT:** Winter wheat emergence continued with 80 percent of the acreage emerged. Crop insect infestation was reported as 26 percent light and 74 percent none. Irrigation water supplies were reported at 4 percent poor, 2 percent fair, 81 percent good, and 13 percent excellent.
