CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION WEEK ENDING NOVEMBER 15 2015

AGRICULTURAL SUMMARY: Warm and dry conditions predominated around the State last week. The number of days suitable for fieldwork was 6.3. South Central Wyoming reported just waiting for winter to hit. Western Wyoming reported it is getting cold with relatively dry El Nino type weather. Stock water supplies across Wyoming were rated 1 percent very short, 17 percent short, and 82 percent adequate.
