CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION MONTH OF JANUARY 2020

AGRICULTURAL SUMMARY: Wyoming experienced slightly above normal temperatures for the month, according to the Mountain Regional Field Office of the National Agricultural Statistics Service, USDA. Moisture levels have shifted some from the last report for December as Southwest, West, and North Central Wyoming are now rated abnormally dry by US Drought Monitor. A reporter from North Central Wyoming reports that conditions have been unseasonably warm and dry. A reporter from Southeastern Wyoming stated that January has been dry. They also reported that it has been an extremely windy weather pattern. They also indicate the area has limited snow cover so livestock are on pasture with common supplements. Hay and roughage supplies for Wyoming were rated 8 percent short and 92 percent adequate, compared to 3 percent very short, 6 percent short, 88 percent adequate, and 3 percent surplus last month. Stock water supplies across Wyoming were rated 1 percent very short, 13 percent short, and 86 percent adequate compared to 1 percent very short, 3 percent short, 95 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus last month.
