SHEEP and LAMBS

The sheep and lambs inventory as of January 1, 2002, on New England farms totaled 47,000 head, 3,000 less than the previous year. Fewer lambs were born during 2001, and the death rate showed a slight increase. Prices received for sheep remained unchanged from 2000, however lamb prices increased slightly but not enough to keep cash receipts from falling six percent to \$2.9 million. New England wool

production totaled 295,000 pounds in 2001, 23,000 pounds below the 2000 output. Producers received an average of 40 cents per pound for fleece, a four cent per pound increase from 2000 wool sales. Total wool output was valued at \$118,000 in 2001. New England operations, with one or more sheep on hand at any time during the year, was 2,000 in 2002, 100 less than the previous year.


